

Xylella fastidiosa





Known outbreaks in Italy, Corsica and mainland France
An outbreak in the UK could lead to destruction of host plants within 100m
An outbreak could lead to a 10km movement ban for host plants for five years
A new plant passporting obligation for all 'professional operators' has been introduced, which requires that the movement of all 'host plants' across the EU must be accompanied by a plant passport
