CLIMATE CHANGE KEY FACTS

- 1 million species are at risk of extinction
- We now have 415 ppm of CO2 up from 280ppm
- Last seen on Earth 3 million years ago when it was 3 degrees warmer, sea levels were 10-20m higher.
- We need to reduce emissions by 45% (from 2010 levels) by 2030
- And net zero by 2050 to have a 50% chance of keeping a liveable, governable planet
- CO2 emissions globally are still increasing
- Our government is currently subsidising fossil fuels via tax breaks
